EARTH DAY

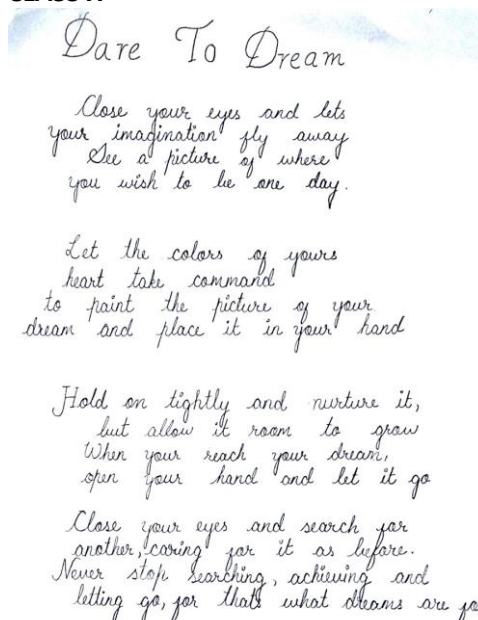

FAREWELL PROGRAM

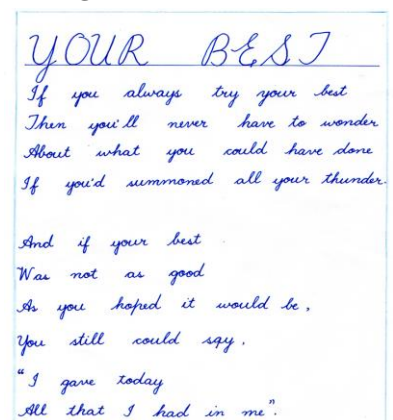
