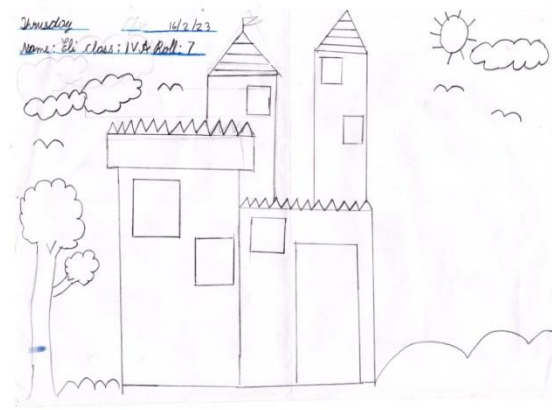
HOPE (YELLOW)
